I. Mission and Faith First

- Luis Gutierrez read a prayer by St. Ignatius of Loyola

II. Mission Statement and Pulse of the Parish

- Mike Pazur noted that it was a big week for HFCA, with the school year starting with 91 new students and 515 total. The theme for the year is “Angels Among Us”
- Luis made several suggestions on hospitality
- Barb asked about celebrating priests birthdays (or not)
- Barb inquired about adding an option to live stream weddings and funerals, which she has seen done at other churches
- Barb noted that Med Las is recovering from his surgery
- Bill mentioned how impressed he always is with baptisms at our Masses and inquired about sending a copy of the subsequent bulletin with picture of the baptism to the family

IV. Pastor’s Report - Fr. Terry

- Father Terry reflected on the hospitality of Abraham sitting outside of his tent in the desert, and encouraged an expansion of SERVANT HOSPITALITY. He notes that servant leadership is for some, while Servant Hospitality is for all. Sue Geegan is working on this structure.
- Many new starts in August and September: Back to School BBQ and Mass, 1st Day of School, Eucharistic Minister Training, Family Faith Kickoff, Catechetical Weekend
- Fall Fest is September 15th and Hops on the Vine on October 5th
- Academy is still looking for a few teachers
- Family Faith needs catechists
- Directors are working on the details of their pillars in the Strategic Plan
- Bishop Rojas participated in a One in Love listening session and hope we can get the word out to other parishes on this much-needed ministry of advocacy

- Providing for Our Family's Future campaign is progressing through a silent phase and will soon open to the broader all-parish phase. The campaign will conclude on December 1
- Vince Perrone was introduced as the new Teen Faith Rep

- Discussion amongst council members ensued on the topic of council size, effectiveness, structure, term length, collaboration between ministries.
