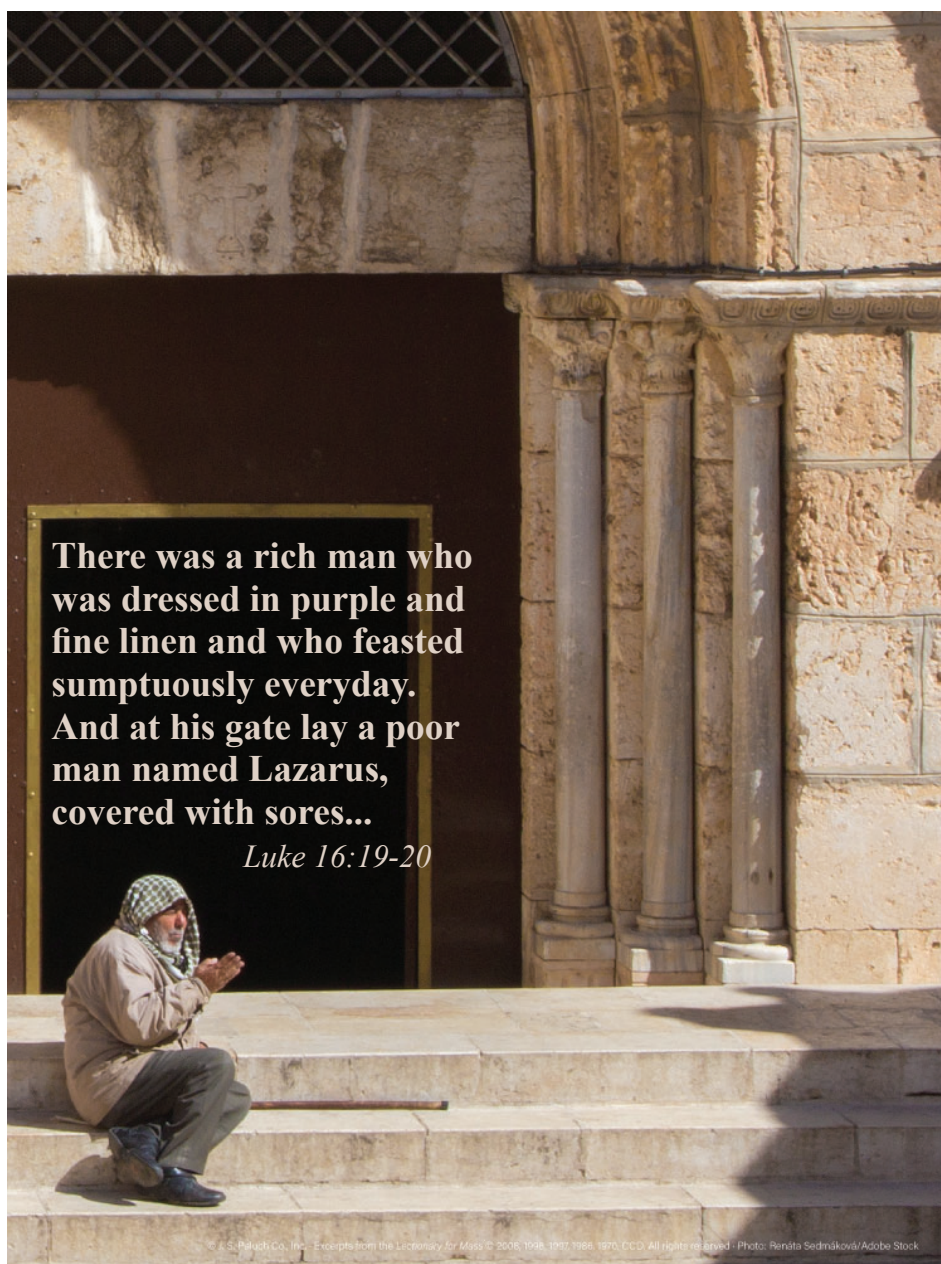

### **The gate that becomes a chasm first exists in our hearts before it can exist between us.**

Today's gospel from Luke invites us to look at the parable of **The Rich Man and Lazarus**. Throughout this parable, **chasms** are the one constant divide. On one side of the gate lies Lazarus, covered in sores and open wounds, hungry and unable to get up and walk. On the other side is the rich man, dressed in fine linen and purple, sitting at his table and feasting every day. A **chasm** is also reflected in eternal life. On the one side of this **chasm** now sits Lazarus, comforted at the bosom of Abraham. On the other side is the rich man, standing in torment in the flames of Hades.

**The gate and the chasm represent the same thing: division and separation.** The chasm that separates Lazarus and the rich man in the next world is simply a manifestation of the gate that separated them in this world. The rich man has now carried it with him into eternal life. It has become the deepest part of him. The gate that **separates** and **divides** are the categories we place ourselves and others in: **rich or poor, black or white, gay or straight, Muslim or Christian**, or any other category we might add to the list. **That gate is a condition of the human heart. The gate that becomes a chasm exists first in our hearts before it can exist between us and another.**

Throughout scriptures, God's presence is uniquely revealed in the lives of men and women who share God's concerns and seek to act as God acts. God is always concerned about the **poor, marginalized, hurting, the broken hearted**, and expects us to be concerned as well. We are all called to **help the poor, feed the hungry, house the homeless, care for the sick, visit prisoners and work for justice**, because that's simply who and what God expects us to be and do. **The question isn't what's in it for me, but what's in it for others.**

We must each **examine our own heart** to find the gates that separate us from ourselves, our neighbors, our enemies, those we love and ultimately God. **What are those gates for you? For me? For this parish?**

**For the United States of America? What gates do we live with? Fear, anger, greed, pride, prejudice, loneliness, sorrow, addiction, busyness, indifference, apathy, hurt, resentment, envy, cynicism?** There are a lot of possibilities for the gates within each one of us. We all have them. That's not how we are intended to live as Christians. That's certainly not how Jesus lived.

**Every time we love our neighbor as ourselves, every time we love our enemies, every time we see and treat one another as created in the image and likeness of God, gates are opened and chasms are filled.** Love is something we are called to live our way into. Love is a choice set before us every day. It can happen in our marriages and families, at work and school and in our prayers for the world. Love can happen in the most intimate of relationships, with strangers, and even with our enemies. It is hard work, but it is possible. Jesus demonstrated love in his life, death and resurrection. **Gates** were opened and **chasms** were filled. **Christ's love, mercy, grace and presence make it possible for us to open our gates and insure they do not become chasms.**

Let us pray: *Lord Jesus, may all our gates be opened and our chasms filled. This is the work you call us to do for the salvation of the world. It is what your kingdom of God looks like. We already have everything we need in you and from you. That was Abraham's point in not sending Lazarus to the rich man's brothers. Abraham was not denying them anything. Nothing was lacking. They already had everything they needed as well. Your "Word" opens gates and fills chasms. It is the same "Word" that was proclaimed by Moses and the prophets, and the same "Word" embodied in the person of Jesus Christ. Lord Jesus, you are the image of an opened gate and a filled chasm. May the image of who we most truly are and who we are to become remain always in our hearts and minds. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.*

**Thank you, again,** for your attention to last weekend's presentation by Bernie Schaeffer, Operations Director and personal commitment shared by Pete Barber, parishioner, usher and Pastoral Council member. The goal was to present the similarities between the management of our personal finances to those of the parish finances, with the added element of scale and difficulties in budgeting with inconsistent unpredictable income. Hopefully, this presented a clearer picture of the need and importance of electronic giving. Currently 40% of our regular contributions come from electronic givers and Pete Barber gave us the challenge of raising the number to 70%. He asked that you prayerfully consider how you can increase your contribution and/or begin electronic giving. Our staff appreciates and thanks you for all your stewardship of OUR Holy Family.

With the close of summer and the many programs, i.e. faith classes and school, back in session, it seemed appropriate to provide a listing of some of the major upgrades, repairs and projects completed this past summer and referenced in previous bulletin articles. This brief list emphasizes the cost of caring for this very large campus and our need to maintain our building reserve (savings) account.

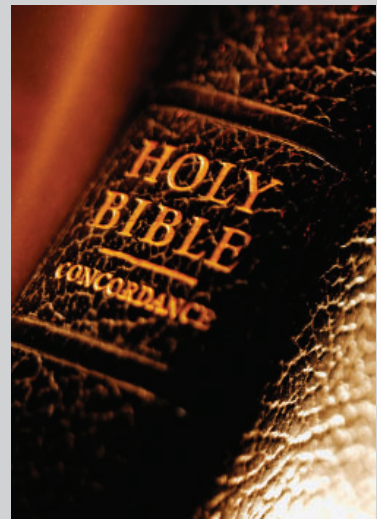

**WE TAKE AND RECORD ATTENDANCE AT EVERY FAITH SESSION. Attendance records are legal documents and can be subpoenaed.**

In the event of an emergency, FTF staff members, and first responders, need to know how many people are on the campus at any given time and where they are on the campus. In case of an emergency, this is critical information needed to guarantee everyone's safety and well-being. For this reason

Having people coming and going at all times throughout the class sessions makes it impossible to provide adequate supervision or control access to and within the building.

### EARLY DISMISSAL

**Step 1:** Parents must inform the catechist prior to the class session that their son/daughter will be leaving early from class.

**Step 2:** Parents must pick-up and sign-out their Pre-K thru Grade 4 children. Catechists will not dismiss a student early from class unless a parent is there to pick him/her, up.

**Step 3:** Students in grades 5-10 must get an Early Dismissal Slip from their catechist and turn it into the Hall Monitor in the Narthex before exiting the building.

At the height of JOURNEYS' winter shelter season in 2018, as temperatures dropped and utility bills soared, there were 11 families consistently dependent on PADS shelters. Currently, only one family remains in their care. Through augmented case management, mental health and a multitude of other supportive services, the agency was able to house the remaining 10 families including 21 children.

Over the past three years, JOURNEYS has successfully housed 414 people who were previously homeless and saved hundreds more households from eviction or foreclosure. Using case management and other reliable resources while acting as advocates has made their success rate simply amazing. ## VIATOR HOUSE OF HOSPITALITY

Dear Viator House Community,

Ali, from Somalia, likes to dream. He once told me that he could never dream about the future in his home country because he spent each day trying to stay alive in the midst of the violence that surrounded him. He came to Viator House two summers ago and had to wait in uncertainty until earlier this month for his asylum interview. The asylum officer told him it might take two more years before he received a decision. But the decision came in two weeks. And Ali won - which means he qualifies to become a U.S. permanent resident and, eventually, a citizen.



### The Viator House Difference

Attorneys tell us that one of the keys to an asylum victory, in addition to a compelling story, is what Viator House offers. At Viator House Ali had frequent access to his attorney, opportunities to grow emotionally and educationally, and a supportive environment that allowed him the piece of mind needed to prepare for his case. None of that takes place in adult immigrant detention, where he would have been transferred two years ago without Viator House.

So the asylum party you see above is a party that you helped plan by your support of Viator House, especially those of you who tutored, mentored and drove Ali to school and back.

Ali - because of you - can now follow his dreams, which include being a pilot. Maybe we'll all find ourselves on a plane in the future with a familiar voice welcoming us..."My name is Ali. I am your captain. The flight time today is..."

The Church's social teaching is a rich treasure of wisdom about building a just society and living lives of holiness amidst the challenges of modern society.

### The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers

The economy must serve people, not the other way around. Work is more than a way to make a living; it is a form of continuing participation in God's creation. If the dignity of work is to be protected, then the basic rights of workers must be respected--the right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to the organization and joining of unions, to private property, and to economic initiative.

Work is, as has been said, an *obligation*, that is to say, a *duty, on the part of man*. . . Man must work, both because the Creator has commanded it and because of his own humanity, which requires work in order to be maintained and developed. Man must work out of regard for others, especially his own family, but also for the society he belongs to, the country of which he is a child, and the whole human family of which he is a member, since he is the heir to the work of generations and at the same time a sharer in building the future of those who will come after him in the succession of history. *On Human Work (Laborem Exercens*. . . ), #16

All people have the right to economic initiative, to productive work, to just wages and benefits, to decent working conditions, as well as to organize and join unions or other associations. (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, *A Catholic Framework for Economic Life*, No. 5)

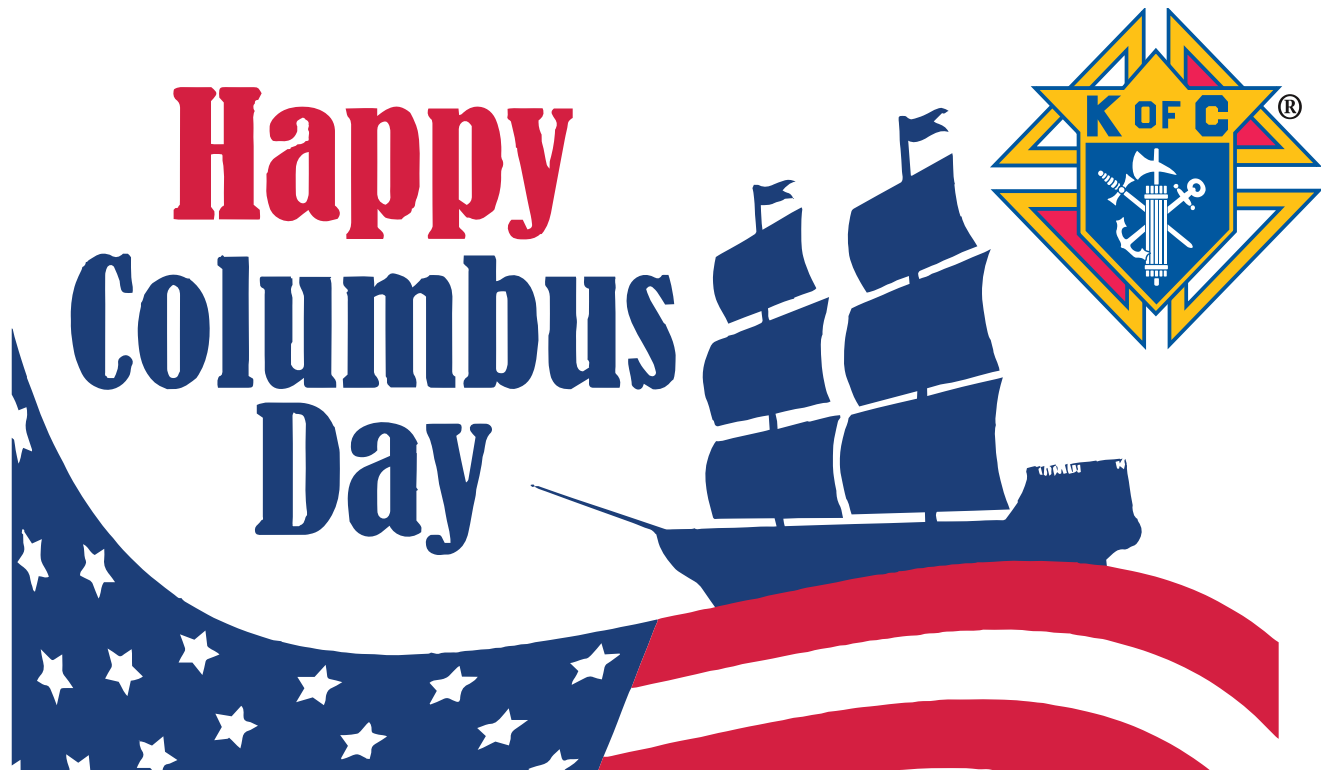
