what: The annual Holy Family Teen Faith Catholic Heart Workcamp Summer Mission Trip! Share the love of Jesus and serve the neglected, brokenhearted and marginalized. Revitalize communities and beautify homes for the elderly, disabled and those who cannot afford needed repairs. Be empowered to live as a disciple of Christ through serving others. Grow spiritually, make new friends and deepen your faith! Be inspired to continue to serve in our local communities!

- Travel with 30 teens from Holy Family to Farmington, MI.
- Join 300 other teens from around the country and get assigned to a work crew and worksite for the week.
- Start each day with Mass and morning program. Travel to your worksite to serve (painting, cleaning, building, clearing, sorting, interacting, etc.) Return to camp to enjoy free time with friends, experience musician-led music and prayer, and interact in high-energy games and activities.
- Help others, grow closer to God, meet new people, and make a difference.

who: Current 8th – 12th graders and adult chaperones 21 yrs +

Teens over 18 at the time of camp need background checks and Virtus training

maximum: 30 teens and 6 adults. \$100 deposit due at registration in addition to any previous past deadline payment amounts.

cost estimate*: \$500 per person (after fundraising goal is \$300)

includes: CHWC programming, transportation, all meals at camp, facilities rentals, liability insurance, supplies and materials, worksite plans, Adult work camp

supervision, morning and evening programs/entertainment, Holy Family T-shirt, CHWC t-shirt and cross, free day activity

mission trip cost breakdown*

Catholic Heart Workcamp cost per teen: \$380 (x 30 teens = 11,400)

Catholic Heart Workcamp cost per chaperone: \$380 (x 6 adults = \$2,280)

Group t-shirt: \$9 each x 36 = \$324

5 Rental vans for the week: \$2,670

6 Gas cards: \$750

Misc Expenses (food, tools/supplies, formational activities) = approx. \$600

Actual cost per teen participant: \$600.80

We do not charge our volunteer adult chaperones for their time or their t-shirt. In addition to that cost, we need to rent 5 vans, plus our Holy Family van, equaling 6 vehicles and 6 gas cards to get to and from camp. All of that plus misc expenses must be covered.

Our goal is to cover all expenses: chaperones, vans, gas, shirts, supplies etc **AND** drop the price to **\$300 per teen**. In order to reach this goal we will need full participation at our fundraisers from each participant!

Payment Schedule is as follows:

- \$100 nonrefundable deposit due at registration to secure spot on a first come basis
- Additional \$100 due by February 1, 2020
- Additional \$100 due by April 1, 2020
- Any remaining balance due by June 7th, 2020
(Final balance will be determined based on fundraising. All fundraising will be divided equally among participants.)

Registrations received after a payment deadline will be required to pay all fees up to that point at the time of registration in order to secure their spot.

Any cancellations received after April 1st will be responsible for the entire cost of the trip.

pasta palooza fundraiser – February 8th 2:30pm-9:30pm

Pasta Palooza is a delicious, table-service, all-you-can-eat, family-style Italian dinner. It is cooked (free of charge!) by the Knights of Columbus and served by our Mission Trip teens in the Holy Family Social Center. This fundraiser involves selling tickets, creating raffle baskets, table set up, serving, and table/room clean up. It is always a lot of fun and we usually get a lot of support from the community. 100% of the profit from this fundraiser will go towards Mission Trip.
