Apostle's Creed – said in unison

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting.

The Our Father

Leader: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come;

thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

All: Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against

us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

The Hail Mary

Leader: Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women,

and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.

All: Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death.

The Glory Be

Leader: Glory be to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit;

All: as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end.

The Salve Regina – Hail Holy Queen – said in unison

Hail, holy Queen, mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To you we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to you we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn, then, most gracious advocate, your eyes of mercy toward us; and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of your womb, Jesus.

Leader: O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

All: Pray for us that we may be worthy of the promises of Christ.

The Glorious Mysteries

Leader: Today when we pray our rosary we are going to think about the wonderful times in Jesus' life and in Mary's life after the Crucifixion.

We call these the Glorious Mysteries.
