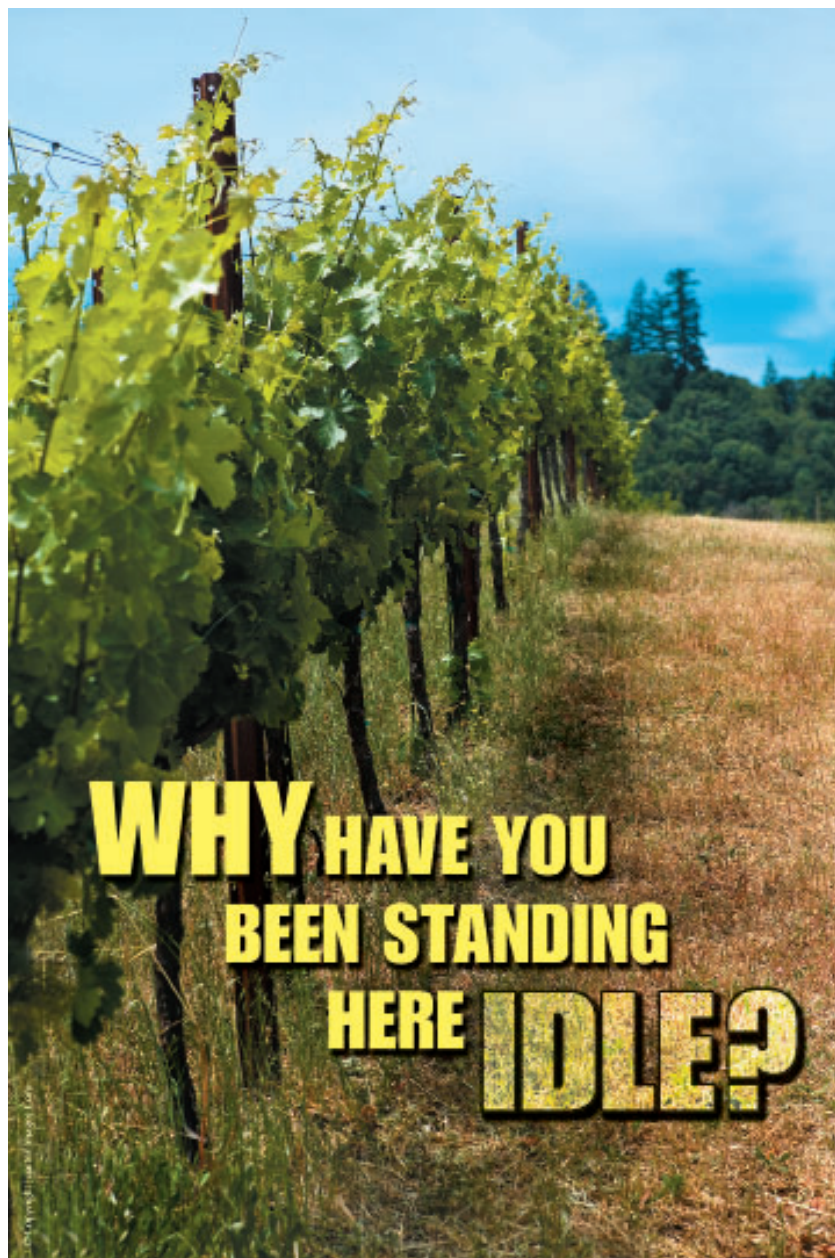

Hope

Where is the Hope these days? We can always find it in various places and we can all be vehicles for it, but there are many people struggling with a lack of hope on many levels these days. Many of you have shared with me and members of our staff your anxiety, stress and other strong emotions that seem to have dashed a communal and personal sense of hope; everything from pandemic uncertainty, racial tension, calls for justice, political disrespect, natural disasters, parental and family concerns related to a decision to either send children to school or balance in home learning with career responsibilities, and more.

Our staff has been consistently and diligently attentive to the changing and varied spiritual needs of our Holy Family Catholic Community. In fact, that seems like ALL we focus on recently asking one of the most basic questions, "What does our community need NOW?" I would like to think that we are always concerned with spiritually feeding our community and the world, but the Covid limitations have altered much of our planning for the larger and longer future in light of the immediate concerns of all of you.

One example is the major spiritual and sacramental two-year pilgrimage that we were planning on beginning this week. We have been collaborating with Dr. Terry Nelson-Johnson and his Soul Play staff for the better part of the past two years to engage our ENTIRE community in renewal, re-evangelization and new life through nine major presentations based on some of the most fundamental experiences of grace and the sacred, with discussions and further action based on those discussions.

The pandemic has put a hold on this major and very ambitious endeavor, but we are not letting it dash our hope.

This Saturday, September 19 from 1-4 pm, parish staff members will distribute a movie giveaway to all who drive into our parking lot. All will receive a popcorn box marked 'Hope Corn' containing microwave popcorn, Twizzlers and a handout describing the following upcoming activities:

- Watch the movie *The Shawshank Redemption*
- Discuss the movie via Zoom on either

Wednesday, October 7 at 7 pm or Friday, October 9 at 1 pm

- Purchase and read the book *On Hope* by Pope Francis and join a Zoom discussion on Monday, October 26 at 7 pm

- Inspirational speaker and friend Dr. Terry Nelson-Johnson will host a mini-retreat on approaching the mystery of hope with humor and grace on Tuesday, December 1 from 6:30-8:30

The 'Hope Corn' boxes will also be available after Masses in the coming weeks. Please take one. Spread the word that we are spreading HOPE.

What have I seen recently that gives me hope? First, the manner in which our Family Faith Staff offered a completely different version of Spirit Camp in the early summer. The creative way that the program was presented also gave families the opportunity to experience Spirit Camp but not confined to the one week that it is normally offered in early June. Virtual Spirit Camp, in fact, reached more families this year and gave birth to some strong collaboration with neighboring parishes.

Secondly, the dedication and diligence of our parish Re-Opening Committee. Scott Swenson as a lead volunteer, along with several other volunteers, have collaborated with staff members Sue Geegan, Bernie Schaeffer, Ro Geisler and our hard working maintenance staff to provide a healthy and clean environment supported by protocols that have kept us Covid free and, God willing, will continue to do so.

Third, the administration, staff, faculty and students of Holy Family Catholic Academy. As I have visited classrooms and heard reports from our Principal Kate O'Brien, the children have practiced and observed mask wearing, social distancing and frequent hand washing. They have been much more compliant than I had expected.

The Crosby, Stills & Nash song "Captain" contains a relevant line, "I can see your hands are roughened by the wheel and the rope. I like to look for you for hope. I think it's hiding there." Look for hope. It may be hiding. Open yourselves up to the HOPE that Holy Family wants to share.

Like all learning, religious education requires consistency.

If you skip this year, your child/teen will, not only lose out on this year's religious education, but incur **learning losses** from previous years.

Advantages of Digital Learning

- **E-Learning is a safer option** at this time.
- **E-Learning provides families with the most flexibility.**
- **E-learning is often more efficient.**
- **E-learning offers us the possibility of personalizing faith formation**, by catering to individual needs. It allows learners to choose their learning path and navigate at their own pace.
- **E-learning leads to better retention.** Modern learners prefer bite-sized, interactive content. E-learning tools enable us to make content interactive.
- **E-learning allows us to engage** our children, teens and parents in **new ways**.

Questions Parents are asking about Faith Classes

Will the FTF schedule remain the same? We are staying quite close to our normal schedule (September-April). The digital learning lessons will be designed to go for 45 minutes rather than our regular 90-minute lessons.

Are you expecting parents to teach their own children if we opt for at home digital learning? **NO!** The teaching part of the lesson will be presented via pre-recorded short videos. If Teen Faith families choose the weekly Zoom classes, Catechists and peer ministers provide the instruction.

Each lesson will include a range of engaging ways for children, teens and parents to choose from in exploring and sharing their faith with one another. For families with younger children, each e-learning lesson is designed to meet the needs of all grade levels, as opposed to separate lessons for each child. Families can do the e-lessons when it is most convenient for their schedule.

Is digital religious education effective? We believe, of course, in-person classes are more beneficial over all. However, at this time it is simply not safe to do so. We also recognize there are advantages digital learning provides (see sidebar)

How will children/teens/families receive their materials? Lesson plans will be posted on the Parish website, along with Flipgrid or Google Classroom links. Families will select a date and time via Sign-Up Genius at the beginning of September to pick-up the other materials they will need to complete the lessons.

Will Tuition Remain the Same? This year we will only use the participating parishioner rate. The Home Faith Tuition scale will follow the same schedule. The 2020-21 tuition schedule is available on the registration link – <https://holyfamilyparish.org/family-and-teen-faith-registration>

Salaries and benefits account for 70% of our annual budget. At the end of June, we cut one full-time position from FTF. Further staff cuts would result in cutting services. We will still need to purchase books and supplies, and this year we will have to pay subscriptions for some e-learning platforms and digital learning tools as well. Some of the learning aids we use in the various classrooms from year to year will now have to be purchased, so each family has access to them.

Statement of Cardinal Cupich on Jacob Blake shooting

Jacob Blake and his family need and deserve our prayers. State investigators have reported that Jacob was shot seven times in the back by a police officer and his family reports that he may never walk again. We also know that his three young children were left traumatized as they watched their father nearly killed before their eyes.

The Blakes have strong roots in Chicagoland and the Black community here. The family is held in high regard, to the point that two affordable senior housing facilities are named after Jacob's late grandfather, a fair-housing activist and pastor at the historic Ebenezer AME Church in Evanston.

Chicago has spent too many years mourning victims of senseless violence. Some take note only when the circumstances are particularly horrific – the death of a toddler, the shooting of youngsters playing in a park. But week after week, the horrors add up, the ones we read about and those we don't, and the pain builds.

Across the nation, people of all creeds and colors are demanding that things change. We cannot continue this way. Racism, inequity and injustice must stop. Gun violence must stop. We must ask ourselves whether we accept living in a nation where a 17-year-old has access to a semi-automatic rifle, which, according to police, he used to commit at least two homicides during protests in Kenosha, wounding a third person, in twisted acts of vigilantism. We must also pray for those victims, aged 36, 26 and 26, respectively, and their families. We are exhausted of saying "enough," for that word seems to have lost its meaning.

Civic, religious and elected leaders in Kenosha and across the nation have rightly called for peace so that justice can be done. They also have called for unity, reminding us that we must take personal responsibility for healing the racism and violence that afflict our nation.

Jacob Blake's mother, Julia Jackson, said it best when she called for peace and healing. "Let's use our hearts, our love, and our intelligence to work together to show the rest of the world how humans are supposed to treat each other. America is great when we behave greatly."

It is time to say "enough," and act like we mean it.
