The weekend of September 19 & 20 we will begin to accept **90 reservations for Mass** which will allow approximately **190 people** to attend. Reservations can be made through the website or simply by calling the main office at 847-359-0042

parish pilgrimage planned that was to begin next weekend. That program has been postponed, and until we can offer that we want to engage all of our community in some spiritual activities urging us to have hope. Profound forgiveness is a matter of heart to heart, sincere, genuine, spiritual reconciling.

Racism Education

In our commitment to address many issues of Racism in our world, we will continue to provide resources for you both here in my article every week and in Sue Geegan's Human Concerns articles, in addition to those found on our website. Like all learning, religious education requires consistency.

If you skip this year, your child/teen will, not only lose out on this year's religious education, but incur learning losses from previous years.

Advantages of Digital Learning

- **E-Learning is a safer option** at this time.
- **E-Learning provides families with the most flexibility.**
- **E-learning is often more efficient.**
- **E-learning offers us the possibility of personalizing faith formation**, by catering to individual needs. It allows learners to choose their learning path and navigate at their own pace.
- **E-learning leads to better retention.** Modern learners prefer bite-sized, interactive content. E-learning tools enable us to make content interactive.
- **E-learning allows us to engage** our children, teens and parents in new ways.

Questions Parents are asking about Faith Classes

Will the FTF schedule remain the same? We are staying quite close to our normal schedule (September-April). The digital learning lessons will be designed to go for 45 minutes rather than our regular 90-minute lessons.

Are you expecting parents to teach their own children if we opt for at home digital learning? **NO!** The teaching part of the lesson will be presented via pre-recorded short videos. If Teen Faith families choose the weekly Zoom classes, Catechists and peer ministers provide the instruction.

Each lesson will include a range of engaging ways for children, teens and parents to choose from in exploring and sharing their faith with one another. For families with younger children, each e-learning lesson is designed to meet the needs of all grade levels, as opposed to separate lessons for each child. Families can do the e-lessons when it is most convenient for their schedule.

Is digital religious education effective? We believe, of course, in-person classes are more beneficial over all. However, at this time it is simply not safe to do so. We also recognize there are advantages digital learning provides (see sidebar)

How will children/teens/families receive their materials? Lesson plans will be posted on the Parish website, along with Flipgrid or Google Classroom links. Families will select a date and time via Sign-Up Genius at the beginning of September to pick-up the other materials they will need to complete the lessons.

Will Tuition Remain the Same? This year we will only use the participating parishioner rate. The Home Faith Tuition scale will follow the same schedule. The 2020-21 tuition schedule is available on the registration link – <https://holyfamilyparish.org/family-and-teen-faith-registration>

Salaries and benefits account for 70% of our annual budget. At the end of June, we cut one full-time position from FTF. Further staff cuts would result in cutting services. We will still need to purchase books and supplies, and this year we will have to pay subscriptions for some e-learning platforms and digital learning tools as well. Some of the learning aids we use in the various classrooms from year to year will now have to be purchased, so each family has access to them.

A Labor Day Message from Arise Chicago *We Belong to Each Other*

In a meeting with workers early on in his Pontificate, Pope Francis prayed:
*"Lord God look down upon us! Look at this city . . . Look upon our families.
Lord, you were not without a job, you were a carpenter, you were happy.
Lord, we have no work.*

*The idols want to rob us of our dignity. The unjust systems want to rob us of hope.
Lord, do not leave us on our own. Help us to help each other; so that we forget
our selfishness a little and feel in our heart the "we", the we of a people who want
to keep on going.*

*Lord Jesus, you were never out of work, give us work and teach us to fight for
work and bless us all."*

This prayer was recited well-before the Pandemic, but it is sadly all too fitting for our current economic crisis: almost sixty million men and women have filed for unemployment, gains made over the decade since the Great Recession has been almost completely wiped out, and about half of the layoffs have been in lower-wage, personal-service jobs. The repercussions are far-reaching, including economic inequality that is now even worse than during the Great Depression. Black and Latinx workers also face much more economic and health insecurity from COVID-19 than others. They face the most lethal pre-existing conditions for coronavirus: racism and economic inequality.

This pandemic has pulled the mask off of the false narrative that leads us to believe that we are separate from one another. Mother Theresa said, "If we have no peace, it is because we have forgotten that we belong to each other." Indeed, our faith teaches that we belong to each other. At a time of crisis such as this, we must turn to our faith, which for me and many of us is the foundation of who we are and how we see the world. From Genesis to the Gospels, Scripture time and time again makes it clear that the treatment of workers is of utmost importance, no matter who they are or where they come from. We are called to love one another.

This is why I am a proud Board Member and supporter of the mission of Arise Chicago. Many of the workers who engage with Arise Chicago are considered "essential" and it is clear that our economy could not run without them, and yet they are some of the worst paid and worst treated in the economy. Their jobs do not provide them proper safety equipment or social distancing. This has led some contracting Covid-19 and tragically dying from the virus. We need groups like Arise Chicago to educate workers on their rights, and support them when they take actions to save not only their lives, but the lives of their families and communities. The task of Arise Chicago to connect faith communities with workers is inextricably linked to the call that because we all belong to each other; we must love each other.

I have met countless workers over the years, men and women, who have inspired me with their courage and heroism to make a difference not only at their job, but in society. Against all odds, they continue to push forward to create a more just world. They do this not to become famous or popular, but because they are compelled to act by their faith. We should change the name of Monday's holiday from Labor Day to A Labor of Love Day, and in so doing, honor all those who historically have and those who will take these same risks.

Let us never again forget that we belong to each other.
