Before The World Changed

When our July to June fiscal year started, Holy Family was already in the second year of a five-year plan intended to drive our growth in a changing environment. We had a number of significant activities and accomplishments during Ordinary Time, Advent and the days leading up to Lent.

A key element in our long-range planning was the launch of "Providing For Our Family's Future." The goal of the campaign was to raise \$3,775,000 to help provide a bright future for the next generation of parishioners. Thanks to your generous support we've received pledges exceeding our financial goal to help build our community through spiritual renewal, sustaining our mission and supporting Catholic education in the Archdiocese of Chicago.



Transformative Worship

Our vision of transformative worship was achieved in many ways. We packed the church on two Sundays to celebrate the Mass of Rock, incorporating modern secular music into the celebration of the liturgy.

Building worship and faith experiences for new generations of worshipers, we opened Kid Kare and continued Kid Church on alternating Sundays. Holy Family also contributed to inter-faith and multi-cultural worship experiences.



Lifelong Learning

Lifelong spiritual growth is a key element of Holy Family's vision. Many of our programs for children, teens, young adults and adults were already making changes and taking innovative approaches before the COVID-19 shutdown.

Family Faith adapted our "First Communion Faith-in Retreat" to be a family centered experience done at home. This reinforced the important influence of parents in a child's faith development.

We re-designed our IGNiTE Lock-in by focusing on the power of peers ministering to peers. The GLOW teens planned all the retreat activities, gave several witness talks, facilitated the small groups and presided over prayer. We also had the largest delegation of teens attend the National Catholic Youth Conference in Holy Family's history thanks to the support of the parish community.



Holy Family celebrated the one-year anniversary of our ABLAZE Ministry by fine-tuning the program to focus on college age young adults. This included the creation of online platforms added to in-person programs to minister to this age group going forward.

In addition to our traditional Bible Journey presentations, Adult Faith focused on working with Dr. Terry Nelson-Johnson and Laura Field through their company, Soul Play, to develop a plan for a spiritual renewal of our parish. The goal was to strengthen the bond of our community and create excitement for living sacramentally. This "Spiritual Makeover" began with over 300 women attending our Advent by Candlelight evening with speaker Laura Field.



Holy Family Academy is another pillar of lifelong learning, with nearly 500 students enrolled in preschool through 8th grade. The Academy is nationally recognized for innovative approaches to education. Consistent with its culture of continuous improvement, representatives from the Academy visited internationally renowned Ron Clark Academy (RCA) in Atlanta. Using RCA's model, we launched a House System in our middle school to develop leadership skills and promote an environment of belonging by strengthening relationships with teachers, students, and families.

Responding **During** A Challenging Time

Human concern needs and solutions were a constant focus before and during the pandemic. In conjunction with our Advent theme of "Higher Love," Holy Family began focusing on racism and the rights of others. We also continued serving specific local needs and quickly changed methods to adapt to new circumstances.

Our Job Support Group was one of the first ministries started at Holy Family. This service became all the more vital when unemployment surged after social distancing restrictions started in the spring. Instead of weekly meetings at the church, the Job Support Group started Zoom meetings with robust attendance. A new website was built for our job seekers and new workshops were added in conjunction with the new Barrington Career Center at no cost. Despite the disruptions, about 63 people secured jobs.

When our PADS (Public Action to Deliver Shelter) site was closed in March, Holy Family became the first location to reach out with funding to provide guests shelter in a hotel. We continued to provide funding and food beyond April. As of the end of June, Holy Family provided 60-90 dinners on a weekly basis.



Worshiping Throughout the Pandemic

As social distancing and pandemic closings began to dominate every aspect of life in March, we quickly adapted our liturgies to this new environment. During this time we were truly living our Lenten theme, "Love First – A Change in Perspective."

We began pre-recorded liturgies on the Third Sunday of Lent. For over five months, our Masses evolved from simply taping the celebrant at the altar, to productions incorporating recorded music and inspiring visual elements to help us stay engaged and inspired.

We also expanded our use of electronic media for many other new or existing worship experiences. New digital resources included "Wednesday Recharge," Fr. Terry's midweek thoughts on a range of topics. Many Small Christian Communities began to meet via Zoom, quickly adapting to new methods of staying in touch.

In person lifelong spiritual growth paused during the start of the pandemic, but quickly moved to remote programming to help keep the community connected. We began a "Tune in with Terry" program with Fr. Terry facilitating discussions on Zoom about many topics, including building community and thoughts

about racism in our world. Zoom was also used for Bible Study and other discussions. Additionally, our staff and 62 volunteers using phone calls and emails reached out to 1,800 families during April and May.

Likewise, the Academy went digital during the shut down. The school stayed connected with students, faculty and families by streaming announcements, prayers and school happenings. Word of our success at e-learning spread and our parish school was recognized nationally in an article in the National Catholic Reporter and locally in the Daily Herald.



Shifting Operational Considerations

Life during the pandemic not only affected our worship, learning and outreach. It also had a significant impact on the day-to-day operation of our campus and the staff who serve our parishioners.

As the pandemic restrictions went into effect we made a seamless conversion to remote working for our staff. During the shut down, we implemented facility cost-reduction measures and prepared a budget for the new fiscal year assuming the ongoing impact of COVID-19 restrictions. To help mitigate the financial impact of the pandemic, we applied for and received a Payroll Protection Plan loan allowing us to continue to pay our Parish and Academy staff for the rest of the fiscal year at pre-pandemic levels.

As restrictions eased, we worked with the Archdiocese on a re-opening process to institute and expand in-person Masses, weddings, funerals, baptisms, and other ceremonies. This involved training the staff and volunteers who would be implementing the new procedures. It also required physical changes at the church, including sanitizing, covering the pews and marking off social distance spaces.

Creating an After

"We Are In This Together ... Before, During and After," but we're still not sure what the "after" will look like.

Over the past few months we have been able to celebrate two Masses a weekend in person and increase the number of worshipers allowed at each Mass. In late September, we also started to live-stream the 9:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. We will continue to plan for Mass adjustments depending on prevailing restrictions, and pray for the day when we can have more Masses and more people at Holy Family. Our vision of "after" will also include full celebrations of baptisms, weddings, funerals and other important rites.



As part of our Spiritual Renewal, we are continuing

programming of Hope. In the months ahead, we will be offering movie and book discussions for adults, and other spiritual enrichment activities. This will build on the work we started with Soul Play before the pandemic. Continuing our efforts to address Human Concerns, we created a statement on "The Sin of Racism," that will help guide our future efforts on human rights.

Our spiritual mission, emphasis on learning and care for others is possible only through the generous support of our parishioners. During the pandemic we have made the appropriate adjustments to be good stewards of our resources. Moving forward, we expect to resume major projects that were postponed during the pandemic, such as the flat roof replacement. Until then, we will continue to manage our budget given the prevailing circumstances. The last section of this report includes the key financial elements for our parish and school.

As we face an uncertain future, rest assured that Holy Family will be guided by the principles of our Vision Statement, Mission Statement and Core Values.


