Advent Theme

Advent ushers in change, but no ordinary one. The change is an Incarnation, when God took a risk and became one of us in the form of an innocent newborn at Christmas. That child then changes into our Lord, Savior and Redeemer, who then ushers in even more change.

This year's Advent/Christmas theme is, "In Crisis, Christ is." You will see from our logo that simply adding an H after the C and a T after the first S that Christ is in Crisis.



CRISIS
In crisis, Christ is.

A significant aspect of crisis calls for an urgent need to change, particularly to heal from a very severe medical issue. To say that we are changing now because of a severe medical issue is one of the greatest understatements ever. The crisis of this Covid pandemic has brought with it a heightened need for change, and the predictable rhythms of expectation, preparation and manifestation that always mark the Advent/Christmas seasons can give us hope this year by embracing Christ even more—seeing him in the midst of crisis. We will begin Mass now by adding to our existing statement of unity. From now on, we will be prompted by:

Mary

Mary's journey of conceiving and bearing the Christ Child is an overall symbol of the world that is called to bear and give birth to the Incarnation, God becoming human in Jesus. We tell two additional stories of Mary that are Feasts of the universal church, The Feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8 and Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12.

The Immaculate Conception is rooted in the significant and unique role that Mary plays in salvation history by conceiving Jesus by the overshadowing of the Holy Spirit.

Our Lady of Guadalupe solidifies Mary as the Patroness of North and South America as she appeared to Juan Diego near Guadalupe, Mexico, speaking to him not only in Spanish but in his local dialect. This indicates a familiarity that Mary has for all of us, because she was so humble in the face of mystery and courage enabling her to do what God and all humanity asked her to do.

2. In Isaiah we also hear that "the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all people shall see it together." What or who reveals the glory of the Lord to you?
3. Peter says: "with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years like one day." How difficult is it to be patient and wait for something in God's time?
4. In several scriptures, John the Baptist is heard to say that he is unworthy, even to untie Jesus' sandals. When you hear this, how do you feel?
5. All of us have been baptized with water. When have you felt baptized in the Holy Spirit? How can we make the Holy Spirit a bigger part of our life?

SOCIAL JUSTICE QUESTION

Jesus came as a voice from the silence – a messenger speaking of compassion and justice. What voice do you hear? Where is that voice leading you?

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY



In early July, SPRING assumed the task of completing a second home this year. The project had been placed on hold by the Habitat affiliate during the height of the pandemic. SPRING volunteers, working in smaller teams to follow prudent safety protocols, completed the project in November. The new homeowner works regularly with our volunteer construction crews, learning all the tips and tricks it takes to build and maintain a home. Habitat does not provide handouts but a hand up. This mother, because of domestic violence and divorce, has progressed from a WINGS resident, to full time employment, and now, homeownership. The mother and daughter will move into their home in time for the upcoming holidays.

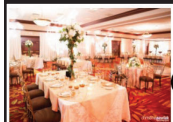
