Holy Family Parish Assist-A-Family Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's):

What Is Assist-A-Family?

Donors (individuals, families, groups) assist specific families one to three times a year, and provide food and gifts according to the following holidays: Thanksgiving; Christmas; Easter

- Specific days for Donors to drop-off their items are scheduled for 2021/2022
Thanksgiving: November 11, 2021
Christmas: December 9, 2021
Easter: March 31, 2022

Who will I be helping?

The Assist-A-Family program helps families from:

- Holy Family Parish
- Mission San Juan Diego
- Partners for our Community (POC)

Will I meet the family I assist?

All donors (and the families they assist) remain anonymous due to confidentiality requirements.

How do I get started?

It's easy to sign-up to become an Assist-A-Family Donor. Simply complete the appropriate sections of the form on the reverse side of this letter indicating:

- Your Individual/Family Donor or Group/Organization Donor Information;
- A specific holiday/dates you prefer;
- A specific size family you prefer.

How and when will I know whom I am helping?

Approximately 4 weeks prior to the drop-off date (see above), donors receive a detailed letter with their family members' first names, ages and sizes.

What am I expected to give?

Gift certificates (Jewel, Dominick's, Target, Wal-Mart, etc.) are encouraged, as they allow families the dignity of shopping for their specific needs. However, food and gifts are also gladly accepted from those who prefer to shop and gift-wrap themselves.
