Father's Day

Happy Father's Day to all of the men who have played an important role in raising children or having a positive influence on the growth and development of others, particularly younger people in our community. I have said to other men in fatherly roles that I can't imagine how they feel as they watch their children grow and develop. My connection with these men has intensified in the past 15 months. Because of the pandemic, bishops have not been able to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with the young people of our communities. We, as pastors, have presided at Confirmation liturgies during the past 15 months. The most recent that I had the honor of presiding at was last Saturday here at Holy Family and I became overcome with emotion a few times because I have watched and been a part of 12 years in the lives of these young parishioners, most of whom were 4 years of age when I arrived. This is part of the honorable title of *Father*.

They have grown in so many ways, and I often feel so fatherly as I see them maturing and embarking on such a significant time of their lives. I am so proud of the Family Faith, Teen Faith and Academy ministries that have prepared the teens for a bright, but also challenging, future.

Let us be grateful for the men who have walked with us, mentored us, shown us respect, worked hard, provided for us and protected us. Let us take the lead of the Holy Spirit who guides us and is celebrated through ritual in a special way in the Sacrament of Confirmation to focus our appreciation and gratitude.

Let us thank our fathers for demonstrating the Gifts of the Holy Spirit: Wisdom - Understanding - Right Judgment - Knowledge - Courage - Reverence and - Wonder and Awe in God's Creation.

Pick out a couple of these gifts, if not all of them that your Dad has demonstrated and tell him how grateful you are.

Energy of Opening

This past weekend brought an energy that has

been unmatched in my time here with you. SO many of you not only returned to church following Covid restrictions but seemed to revel in the physical exchanges of unity and welcoming. Hugs, handshakes and embraces were accompanied with such joy and appreciation. The energy in church as well as the Narthex was phenomenal.

As we move forward, please be aware that we can all sing again. I noticed many still refraining from congregational singing, perhaps out of habits formed in the past year and a half. Please continue to only receive Communion in the hand as doing otherwise requires extra sanitization for the Eucharistic Ministers and could still present a risk in spreading disease. Please notice that there is a special section in the front of the church near the tabernacle and Holy Family sculpture reserved for those who wish to continue to wear masks and practice social distancing for whatever reason.

Masks and social distancing are no longer required for those who have been fully vaccinated. Masks and social distancing are recommended for those who have yet to be vaccinated. Registration is no longer required for weekend Mass, daily Mass and the Sacrament of Reconciliation (which will continue to be offered each Monday from 5-6:30 in the church.)

Crossing Over Fear

This weekend's Gospel passage from Mark uses the violent squall on the Sea of Galilee as a metaphor for challenges and difficulties in life. Jesus begins by proclaiming, "Let us cross to the other side." I believe he means let us cross over the fear of the challenges and storms that we encounter. Fear is so understandable in the face of challenge, particularly those that we might not know where to begin to address. Such challenges often paralyze us with FEAR. Jesus is not afraid of such challenges, so much so that he is at rest in the midst of the storm on the sea. The disciples seem to lack faith in the midst of the storm.

We can never perfectly execute the gift of faith that Jesus can, but we can integrate our faith into our lives to cross over fear.

The Liturgical Arts Community... creates a vibrant prayer and worship experience so that all may participate in a fully conscious and active way in the liturgy. This includes different forms of prayer and worship experiences, for all attending Holy Family.

Masks – will no longer be required for vaccinated persons but will become optional. If you are unvaccinated, it is recommended you wear masks indoors. You will not be asked if your vaccination status.

Social Distancing – If you find you are more comfortable sitting socially distanced, the area in the front near the tabernacle will be available and an usher can assist you.

We will have hand sanitizer stations available for your convenience at both entrances. It is no longer necessary to sanitize your hands prior to receiving communion.

We will continue with **4 Communion stations** until we have fully re-engaged our Eucharistic Ministry.

Distribution of Holy Communion from the cup remains suspended at this time.

There will no longer be any restrictions on singing! We ask you to sing and be joyful again.

The Sign of Peace is restored but please extend the Sign of Peace in a way that is comfortable for you.

We have removed all blue tape on the pews and the plastic covers and our fonts are once again flowing with the waters of new life.

Our East entrance will be open again for your convenience.

We welcome you to gather in the Narthex before and after Mass. Hospitality will be available in the fall when we have re-engaged our Hospitality Ministry.






