→ 21 weekly online lessons done at home, with the parent serving as the principal catechist

Note: We ask that you choose one (1) of the options for the year, as opposed to choosing a different option each week so we can recruit and train enough catechists. Tuition is the same for all three options. Tuition assistance is available to all registered parishioners.
