






The word Bible comes from the Greek word  $\tau \dot{\alpha}$   $\beta \iota \beta \lambda i \alpha$  ta or biblia meaning "the books".

Therefore, the Bible is not a book it is a collection of writings – 73 books; 46 in the Old Testament or Hebrew Scriptures; 27 in New Testament or Christian Scriptures. These books were written over hundreds of years by countless authors and editors.






## The important ideas!


#### The Call of Jeremiah

(Jeremiah 1:1-19)


God has revealed himself and inspired individuals throughout salvation history.
