"WHO IS JESUS?" PROJECT

- Over the coming class-periods, classes will be working towards completing a project on "*Who Is Jesus*?" to be presented on April 10th in the Chapel.
- Over the weeks, classes will dive into the Gospels, looking at the stories in them. Classes will work on examining the gospels and the life of Jesus to work towards a project (described below). To do this, classes can take each week to examine the different gospels and the stories in them.
- Take time today to brainstorm as a class what your project could look like or share ideas about what type of project you might do.

What will this final project look like?

In short, anything you want!

In long, it will be a visual representation of Jesus. If it's a picture, we will hang it up in the church for the entire parish to see. You have plenty of time to brainstorm and execute, so give us your <u>best</u> work!

Some ideas Teen Faith has come up with:

- One story in the gospel drawn out and showing the work of Jesus
- Symbols representing Jesus and who He is
- A poem or song (Dr. Peg recommends a Hamilton-style rap)
- The healing stories of Jesus from Luke (skit)
- A timeline of Jesus' life
- A mosaic
- One gospel with many stories
- All four gospels being compared/contrasted
- A collage
- Word art
- Paint
- Magazines
- Paint
- Chalk
- Pens/markers
- Something 3D!

Just let Teen Faith know what you need, and we will get you the supplies! Feel free to be as creative as you want. You have plenty of time and resources to come up with something truly unique!
