## Fr. Terry Keehan

One of the most popular pilgrimages in Scripture is the one told in this weekend's celebration of the Epiphany. It is indeed an adventure in grace that can be seen as a hinge, so to speak, connecting the birth of Jesus and his baptism, which we celebrate next weekend and which begins his public ministry as an adult. We are referring to many voyages as pilgrimages because a pilgrimage involves pilgrims (us) and it reveals a lot of grace.

As we all engage our hearts and souls in the ongoing larger pilgrimage of the Christmas season, let's consider the many sacraments mediated by many people and events as well as hailing who is full of grace.

The Gospel of Matthew tells us of the journey that the Kings/Wise Men/Magi take, how they got off track by stopping in the large city of Jerusalem near their true destination of Bethlehem. The story really begins with the prophet Isaiah's call to, "Rise up in splendor Jerusalem! Your light has come...upon you the Lord shines." It continues, telling us specifically that camels and caravans shall come from the east bearing gifts of gold and frankincense (Isaiah 60:1-6)

So many people through the centuries have received the sacrament of God's light mediated by the many scriptural parts of this story.

The Kings or Wise Men receive the sacrament of companionship mediated by each other. They received the sacrament of wonder mediated by the special star. In their own way they surely proclaimed, "Hail Star, full of grace."

But the whole Christmas pilgrimage is not without more vulnerable human emotions. Our beloved founding pastor Fr. Med Laz points out something interesting in his beautiful Christmas message. He tells us a story of Gabriel returning to heaven with both good news and bad news for God. The good news is that every time he appears to human beings including Mary, Joseph, shepherds, even the father of John the Baptist, Zechariah, they do in fact carry out the message that he delivered from God. The bad news is that everybody appears to be afraid of God because he has to say over and over, "Do not be afraid."

In our pilgrimage of life, the more vulnerable, fearful, tragic events may initially be perceived as anything but grace. But I hope the year-long *Adventures in Grace* which we are taking has already invited you to consider how events in your life that were very difficult to endure or swallow have put into place a process of revealing grace in some unpredictable and even uncontrollable ways.

Please continue to use the formulas:

I received the sacrament of \_\_\_\_\_

Hail \_\_\_\_\_ full of grace!

In my own life the initial diagnosis of hepatitis as a junior in college was a major setback. Not only did I miss most of the basketball season, but I was laid very humble by a virus that was initially perceived as unfortunate. As my life has unfolded I have discovered at least two major experiences of grace in the wake of my illness. The first is how determined I was to return for my senior year of basketball in the best shape of my life. I believe that I did just that. Secondly, it has given me an appreciation of the value of health and the health care field that I entered into as a salesman and that I interact with almost every day as I visit and pray with people who are seriously ill.

I am sure many who were present at the actual Baptism of Jesus said in these or similar words, "I witnessed the sacrament of immersion mediated by the Baptist."

All of the Christmas pilgrimage of grace tells us how the redeeming grace of God our savior, manifest in the Christ baby/child and mediated by the Holy Spirit, enters our world, in time many years ago and over and over again in our lives today.

Of the pilgrimage the song *Silent Night* sings:  
*Radiant beams from thy holy face  
With the dawn of redeeming Grace*

Let us all let the redeeming grace of God dawn in our lives.





Happy New Year! May it be a healthy and rewarding one for all, filled with love, sharing and a renewed focus on gratitude for all that we've been given.

Every New Year signals an opportunity to start anew, to work on self improvement, fulfilling promises we've made to ourselves and others, through New Year's resolutions. But renewal isn't just once a year, it happens every day, every hour, every minute of our lives. We can all make it happen continuously if we learn to recognize and share the wonders of God's grace that was given unconditionally to us all. And that's what our "Adventures in Grace: a pilgrimage" program is all about.
