Renew My Church

Please note that for Holy Family and St. Anne this process DOES NOT mean that we are merging parishes, closing or eliminating facilities, programs, ministries or activities. Certainly in all major categories of health and effectiveness, both of our parishes are strong and vibrant. The purpose of our version of Renew My Church will be to share ideas, insights and some parish statistical data that will assist in future initiatives to RENEW the Catholic Church's presence in our two parish area. This initiative is designed to build upon the planning that both of our parishes have already begun individually, and will be facilitated by members of the Archdiocesan Renew My Church team. More details will follow.

First Communion

This weekend and next we will celebrate First Communion with many of our younger parishioners from both Family Faith and our Academy. Some children will also celebrate this most important moment at selected weekend Masses. I want to thank Dr. Peg Hanrahan and her staff in Family Faith and our Principal Kate O'Brien and her staff for preparing, forming and celebrating with our children.
