We've all seen the pictures of homeless veterans struggling to regain their footing when returning to civilian life. They risked their lives for us. - You should have received an invitation to set up a **REALM** Account via email. If you have **not received** your REALM invitation [use this registration link](#). OR Contact jswenson@holyfamilyparish.org to request a REALM invitation. You will be asked to create a **user name** and **password**. This takes about 15 seconds.

NOTE: Please set your account up ASAP as the link is only active for 24 hours.

Step 3: How to register for Faith classes

- a. Log in to your realm account
- b. From your new REALM Account, you will see all of your family information. If you see anything that needs to be correct, please do so.
- c. Click on the Faith Registration Link. Follow the prompts.

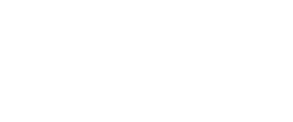
