Humility and Entitlement

We continue hearing passionate, strong words from the Gospel of Luke this weekend. Remember that Jesus is on a journey or mission to Jerusalem and is trying to both challenge and teach as he goes. He admonishes those who seek to sit at places of honor, but also seem to think that they are entitled to those positions. He proclaims, "For everyone who exalts themselves will be humbled, but the one who humbles themselves will be exalted."

Entitlement can be subtle and it can be blatant. Whenever there is a lane closure or a lane ends on a busy road, particularly when people are in a hurry during rush hour, you see examples of entitlement all the time. Drivers race up as far as they can go and then try to merge at the last minute, almost always without using an indicator to convey their intention.

Now I don't know the background of each of these events. Perhaps they have an emergency requiring them to arrive at a destination quickly, but I can't help but feel most of the time they simply feel entitled. They assume someone will let them in and most of the time that happens. I suspect it conveys an 'I am more important than you' attitude. It demonstrates a lack of awareness that others might be in a hurry as well. It also

often demonstrates a complete lack of awareness of basic driving etiquette that is another form of entitlement.

Beyond driving, I see many examples of an attitude that says, "I have not come to serve but to be served," which is the exact opposite of the statement that Jesus made. Let's heed the Gospel message and check the subtleties of our entitlement. Let's increase our awareness of others and their needs that will hopefully lead to action that says, "I have come to serve not to be served."

The Adventure Continues!

Our year-long **Adventures in Grace** pilgrimage culminated with a Spirit-filled Pentecost celebration in June. At that Mass, we stood, fully aware of our identity as Beloved of God, and committed ourselves, actively and passionately, to continued **grace-filled adventures** in both our daily lives, and as a faith community. With that commitment in mind, we'd like to inform you of how we will continue to pursue **Adventures in Grace (AiG)** over the next year here at Holy Family.

Beginning in the fall and continuing through May 2023 we will be offering four Wednesday evening events based on the spirituality of tenderness: Tenderness and Forgiveness, Tenderness in Relationships, Tenderness Toward Creation, and Tenderness in Prayer. These events will include a noted speaker, opportunity for small-group discussion, and hospitality.

We will also be promoting, and offering book discussions on, Fr. Greg Boyle's newest book *The Whole Language: The Power of Extravagant Tenderness*, a call to witness the transformative power of tenderness, rooted in his lifetime of experience ministering to gang members in Los Angeles. This book has been the inspiration for our spirituality of tenderness programming.

There will be a renewed focus on the creation of small Christian communities (Gatherings in Grace) devoted to small-group discussions of experiences of Grace in daily life and in the Sunday scripture readings, as well as other topics.

During Lent, our pastor, Fr. Terry, will lead a two-day parish mission on the spirituality of Holy Week.

We will also be continuing our popular Bible Journey program and powerful Beloved Retreat, as well as opportunities to serve in a variety of social justice/outreach projects.

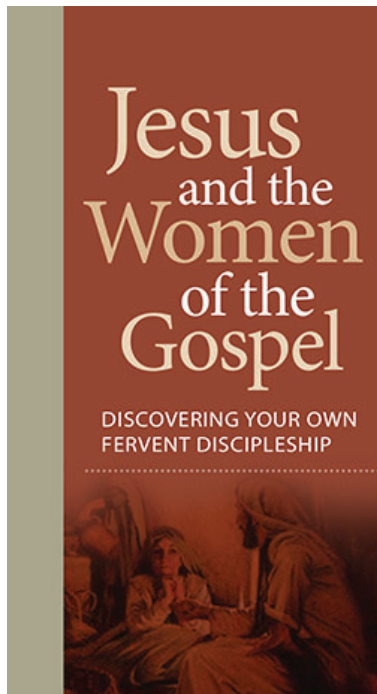

Franciscan Works is a Catholic missionary organization dedicated to breaking the cycle of poverty for children and families through material and spiritual support and a Catholic education. Franciscan Works currently operates Liberia Mission in West Africa. We welcome speakers Bob and Kathy O'Dwyer at all Masses next weekend.

Founded in 2003, just as the civil war was ending, Liberia Mission began with six orphaned children. Today it is a vibrant, life-saving community of love, learning, work and prayer, with 45 residents. Nearly 450 youth from surrounding villages attend St. Anthony of Padua Mission Grade School or are funded to attend local high schools. These are young people who would not otherwise have access to education, medical care, adequate food and shelter, faith formation, and the sacraments. St. Michael the Archangel Church, located on the Mission, serves the students and the community. A student-run farm and piggery are part of the vocational education the students receive. These children are learning to become future leaders in their families, communities and country. Much prayer, joy and hope is evident at Liberia Mission, even with the sorrow and hardships associated with the Ebola outbreak of 2014, the ongoing pandemic, and the political and economic strife there. Many challenges remain.

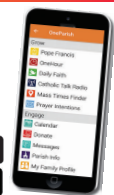
