## AMEN to Generosity and Service from Our Youth


This season is one of receiving, but we encourage our younger parishioners to give and this year they have demonstrated unbelievable generosity.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

"The Word was made flesh, and he made his dwelling among us." These momentous words from the beginning of John's Gospel describe exactly what we celebrate at Christmas. Jesus, the eternal Son of God, has indeed come among us and become a part of our human family. He shared our joys and our sorrows. He came to know the full expanse of our human experiences, those that lift us up and those that cast us down. Through his death and resurrection, he has transformed our lives and our very world. ## "The Word of God became a man and lived among us."

**Christmas is a Festival of Love.** It celebrates the mystery of the Incarnation – our belief that God freely chose to become one of us, in order to draw closer to us in love.

**Take your time with Christmas. Celebrate all Twelve Days of Christmas.** Help your children and grandchildren savor the sights, sounds, flavors, and scents of the season. Embed the meaning of Christ's birth in their hearts by celebrating your family's traditions with them. Talk with them about how your traditions were started and evolved, and why they are important to **you**. Ask your kids about what traditions are meaningful to them and **why?** Leave space to create new traditions.

**Find moments to pray with your children, no matter how old they are.** Prayer does not have to be formal, structured or lengthy. Listen to carols together, take a quiet moment together in front of the Christmas tree to say one thing you are thankful for, wish God's blessing on them whenever the mood strikes you, or say a simple prayer of thanks or praise before or after meals. Teach your kids that hugs, cuddles, kisses, and snuggles are wonderful prayers, because they are ways to be reminded of and share God's love.
